

**LEGAL NOTICE**

**CLARENCE FIRE DISTRICT NO. 1  
NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

Sealed bids for the improvement of the parking lot/training area located to the rear of the Clarence Fire District No. 1 property located at 10355 Main Street, Clarence, New York will be received and opened at a public bid opening on Monday, June 9, 2014 at 7:00 P.M.

Bidding shall be in accordance with the instructions to bidders. The bidding will be in two sections: (Part A and Part B). Part A and Part B will be bid separately.

- Part A will be the paving of the area, including the approach from the Town of Clarence bike path and the driveway from the parking lot directly behind the Fire Hall (to the east of the metal storage building) to the parking lot/training area. The specifics of Part A are noted on the Site/Grading Plan C-101.
- Part B will be the boring of holes and setting of wooden poles supplied by the Contractor at specific locations indicated by orange stakes marked by the Fire District around the lot. The specifics of Part B are noted on the Site/Grading Plan C-101.
- All electrical (lighting, wiring, etc.) work will be completed by Clarence Fire District No. 1.

Specifications may be obtained by contacting Clarence Fire District No. 1 at 716-759-8842 or Jim Schlabach via cell at 716-570-2798. Prevailing wages shall be paid pursuant to New York State Labor Law.

All bids shall be addressed to: Fire District Secretary, Clarence Fire District No. 1, 10355 Main Street, PO Box 340, Clarence, NY 14031 and must be clearly marked on the outside of the envelope: Parking Lot/Training Area Bid – Part A or Part B.

Bids will be binding for 90 days subsequent to the bid opening.

The Board of Fire Commissioners will accept the bids of the lowest responsible bidders. The Board specifically reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

All bids must be accompanied by a Statement of Non-Collusion in statutory form pursuant to the applicable Laws of the State of New York.
